ELIGIBILITY

- ✓ Must be a high school senior attending a public or private-secondary school in Nebraska.
- ✓ Must attend a post-secondary institution during the 2018-2019 school year.
- ✓ The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- ✓ Write an essay that describes how your school counselor or the school counselor program has assisted you to plan/decide/resolve/grow in an area of your life. Topics may come from any related Pre-K-12 experience and are not limited to only the college or career planning process. We will award three (3) \$500 scholarships to competitively selected recipients.
- ✓ Essays are limited to 500 words and will be reviewed for content and grammar.
- ✓ Essays should be typed and double-spaced. Do not put your name, your counselor's name, or the name of your school on the essay. Failure to follow these guidelines will disqualify the applicant from consideration.
- ✓ Include a wallet size photograph of yourself with a completed application. The photographs will not be returned and incomplete applications will not be scored.
- ✓ Send one (1) copy of the essay and the completed application form to:
